## **APPLICATION GUIDELINES** (Please read carefully)

ALL students in the Traditional College (TRAD) are expected to live on campus, with exceptions as follows:

- Commuters living with parents or adult relatives within a one-hour driving distance from campus
- Married students or students with dependents in their care
- Students 21 years of age or older
- Students who have junior or senior standing as defined by the College Registrar
- Students participating in approved academic experiences such as guest semesters, semesters abroad, or semesters at other institutions, etc.
- Student teachers with special location needs

Permission to live off campus for reasons other than those falling within the policy guidelines will be granted due to extreme or extraordinary circumstances only. Students who seek exemption should submit a petition describing the circumstances that justify an exemption along with this completed form. Exemption requests must still be reviewed by Financial Aid and submitted to the Director of Residence Life by stated deadlines but approval determination will rest with the Dean of Students and the Faculty Committee on Student Affairs.

All petitions for off campus housing need to be submitted to the Director of Residence Life no later than April 16th for the coming fall semester and November 15<sup>th</sup> for the coming spring semester. Requests from new entering students to live off campus must be received by the Director of Residence Life no later than 30 days prior to the start of the semester in which they are entering. Please note: applications received after the deadline may be denied outright or may be deferred for consideration until the following semester. Applicants who miss the deadline should consult with the Residence Life Director.
